**Abstract:** The Yavapai Heritage Foundation and the City of Prescott Historic Preservation Office conducted surveys of more than 1200 territorial buildings in and around the original Prescott town site. Some of these were investigated even further and many were determined for inclusion in the National Register. The surveys and research done on properties provides valuable history about the properties and community and are a significant resource to the public. The Yavapai Heritage Foundation's efforts have helped Prescott be recognized for its historic value nationally and has given it an economical boost in the process.

## **Biographical History**

Yavapai Heritage Foundation, Prescott, Arizona, was founded as a non-profit Arizona corporation in 1974 in response to a grant opportunity to move the Bashford House and conduct the first Arizona survey of historic properties. The foundation was active for



more than thirty-four years in the study of the history of the region, historic preservation pursuits, economic and downtown development planning, publications, and activities around the county assisting other groups in historic preservation studies. Yavapai Heritage Foundation was also the volunteer organization responsible for the development of a city ordinance creating the first municipal historic register and the first historic building code in the state. Yavapai Heritage Foundation successfully acquired a wide variety of grants from local, state and national sources. Elisabeth F. Ruffner was the founding president.

The foundation was dissolved in 2008 after successfully transferring historic preservation responsibilities to the City of Prescott. All Yavapai Heritage Foundation press books and records have been deposited at Sharlot Hall Museum for archival research purposes.

## **Scope and Content Note**

This collection of papers represents a tremendous amount of volunteer time and effort to preserve and enhance the historic value of the greater Prescott area. Hundreds of volunteers collaborated in many ways to record and preserve things of historic significance related to homes, businesses, buildings, churches and people. At the core of this project was the newspaper survey done by volunteers as well as the surveys of homes and buildings. These surveys also included many photographs that will become even more valuable over time. Another significant addition was the variety of projects the foundation organized to lend greater significance to Prescott's history such as installing historical lamp posts and the Forests and Grasslands project.

Researchers will want to use this collection to enhance their research on people who lived in the Prescott area. By determining where they lived and using this collection they can enhance their knowledge of individuals and families.

Elisabeth Ruffner kept an incredible historical record of the organization by saving all the newspaper clippings referring to Yavapai Heritage Foundation over the life of the foundation.

The administrative series is a testament to the core of volunteers who care about Prescott's history. By perusing this material it is evident that a core group of people's commitment to history in Prescott changed the way Prescott is perceived and always will be. If you want to understand the Prescott area, this collection is a great place to start.

**Series Scope & Content:** This series contains typed index cards with information from old newspapers about historic properties in the Prescott area. Volunteers would be assigned newspapers to read. These newspapers were hardcopy and microfilm mostly including the Arizona Miner, the Weekly Arizona Miner, the Arizona Journal Minor, the Morning Courier, The Prescott Weekly Courier, etc. They would record any article which described building activity, noteworthy events, community development, or overviews of conditions within the community. Text was referenced by places, people, building name and topics. These were recorded on cards and filed. (See Box 17, folder 2 for the newspaper readers’ guide and listing of newspapers searched.) Any cards that pertained to properties listed in Series 1 have been included in the individual folders. Occasionally something of relevance is found in these cards, but newer sources such as Chronicling America, The Library of Congress Newspaper project make this somewhat irrelevant. Researchers may find them valuable to browse because of the volume of man hours spent compiling these noteworthy items. (These were formerly document boxes 386-390.)
